

# FROM MONEY TO LOVE:

## Journey to a New Paradigm

A Self-Paced, Seven-Session Correspondence Course and Discussion Group

**Lakshmi is the Hindu goddess of love, money, beauty and perfection. She personifies the timeless connection between money and love and the ancient knowledge that they are one and the same energy.**

Most people can feel something extraordinary is coming in our world. With each new day, it feels as though time is accelerating exponentially and we are rushing headlong into an uncertain future. What is this phenomenon? Are we plunging into destruction and disaster, or are we poised for rebirth and renewal, ready to enter a new, golden age of enlightenment?

Despite some positive signs, everywhere we turn we seem to be bombarded by bad news: wars, pandemics, ecological disasters, pollution, environmental destruction, extinction of species, climate change, economic failure, energy crises, unsustainable reliance on fossil fuels, and the extraordinary greed and corruption of governments, corporations and individuals worldwide. Even with these incentives to change and even with our best intentions, we still have trouble changing—because of our limited, polarized mindset.

As spiritual seekers, how do we cope with all of this uncertainty, negativity and potential gloom and doom, which certainly does seem like it is the reality of our modern world? Some days it feels easiest just to ignore it all. But is that really a solution?

Our intention for the course is multifold. We focus on four primary ways of coping and flourishing in the coming times and on how to help ameliorate the circumstances in our personal lives and in the world: 1) keeping our spiritual path at the heart of daily life, 2) staying informed about what is happening in the world, 3) recognizing that in addition to the death of the old, outmoded systems, exciting and inspiring signs of the birth of a new, love-based paradigm are becoming more and more evident, and 4) exploring “Sacred Activism”, which author Andrew Harvey describes as the fusion of sacred consciousness, passion, generosity and peace with wise action. These are all vitally important issues to give our attention to as spiritual seekers. With information comes empowerment. With a shift in mindset comes awakening. And from this comes love in action, change and the birth of a new world.

In this course we read books, watch films and listen to the audio recordings of talks from the live class of 2009, all of which focus primarily on the topics of: economy, environment and energy. We view these topics through the lens of personal transformation and spiritual growth, and we discuss our research and insights via regular phone-bridge and Internet dialogues with a CoreLight teacher and/or Brad Laughlin and other class members. We especially concentrate on the subject of money – on our personal relationship with money, on clearing the shadows around money, on the history and future of our financial system, and on how we can each contribute to the birthing of a new love-based paradigm right now in the present.

Although everyone is at a different level of understanding of these subjects and comes to the course with varying degrees of knowledge, the discussions are intended for anyone, at any level, based on the premise that we can all contribute and learn from each other.

**Some of the specific questions we address in our discussions are:**

- What is the connection between money and love?
- How can we live a truly abundant life?
- What can we do to move beyond the fear associated with a potential economic crash?
- What can we do to help the Earth and humanity at this critical juncture?
- What are the real sources of the problems society faces today, and what can we do about them?
- Personally and collectively, what changes are important to make in the coming times, and how do we make them?
- Who benefits from war and how does it hold our economy in place?
- What role will China play in the coming changes?
- What is 2012 about? What is all the talk about “the end of the world”?
- What examples can we learn from as we face potential hard times ahead?
- How do we continue to stay informed and help in an ongoing way?

### **What is required to participate in this course:**

- Listen to two audio sets of Leslie's—*For Love and Money*, and *Selfless Giving*—available through *CoreLight* on CD and mp3. Please note: *For Love and Money* was a seminar Leslie taught several years ago, which has recently been digitally remastered and edited. Participants in this course receive a 15% discount on the purchase price.
- Read three books and several magazine and Internet articles
- Watch ten films and one online power-point presentation.
- Listen to the mp3 recordings of the discussions from the 2009 From Money to Love class, which you can download from the online conference site.
- Participation in regular phone bridge discussions with a CoreLight teacher; times and dates to be discussed. Also, if you have to miss any of these sessions, you can download them as mp3 recordings from our online conference site.
- Participate ongoingly in an online chat room forum, where we discuss the class topics. This forum is asynchronous, and so you can participate at any time.

- Tuition is a suggested minimum donation of \$200, which includes the cost of the online material and recordings, the cost of the phone conference calls (for eight conference calls) but does not cover other materials (*For Love and Money* and *Selfless Giving* recordings, and any of the films and books that are required).

- The discussions and ongoing Internet forum will be facilitated by a CoreLight teacher and/or Brad Laughlin. We will share and process as a group with the intention to learn from each other, grow spiritually and help the Earth. Our time together offers an opportunity to discuss, process, share and ask questions about anything related to the class.
- Leslie is very enthusiastic about this timely material, and you can hear her as the co-facilitator on all of the mp3 recordings made during the 2009 conference calls. She gives a powerful guided meditation at the end of each class, which helps us to access new spiritual alignments through a special transmission that is directly related to the class material.
- The ongoing online forum offers an opportunity to discuss what you read and hear, process any reactions that arise, share your ideas and insights, and ask questions about issues related to the classes. Through the books, articles, videos and audio, our intention is to gather new information and become empowered by it, and to recognize and understand the inspiring signs of the birth of the new, love-based paradigm in order to participate in it more fully.

# CLASS SYLLABUS

## **Class 1: “Living in the Flow—The Journey from Money to Love”**

Through living in an awakened state of consciousness, we discover that we are sustained at all moments by an all-nourishing love, which meets all of our needs. This seems like insanity to the ego, but it is the universal experience of all those who have awakened. With a transformed state of consciousness, everything that humanity recognizes as beautiful and fulfilling becomes available, including wealth. Authentic wealth is enlightened consciousness, and when it is aligned with money, a torrent of grace, love and abundance flows through us, weaving matter and spirit together in daily life in a golden web of light.

As Leslie says: “It’s not sex [or money] itself – there’s nothing wrong with that. It’s what we do with it in our heads that’s the problem. We say money is the root all evil, too, and actually money is just money. Our heads are what distort money, sex and power. So, rather than avoiding those three things, we need to enlighten them. We’re going to have to see what’s going on in our minds, bodies and emotions to understand what’s driving us in these areas.”

## **Class 2: “Breakthrough or Breakdown?”**

We see the necessity for a new vision of money. The world’s systems are collapsing, and humanity has on its hands an unprecedented economic and environmental crisis. The Earth is facing what scientist and author Erwin Laszlo calls a “chaos point”, and we are teetering at the cusp of another turning of an Age. One of the most destructive systems on the planet right now is the economic system. Because the issue of money touches almost every aspect of life, both global and personal, enough people clearing their money issues could create a tipping point that would turn the world around.

Humanity must urgently transform its consciousness from a culture of greed, materialism, consumerism and exploitation into one of love, sustainable practices and humanism. The only wisdom we have to fall back on comes from the knowledge of the world’s great spiritual traditions—the teachings of compassion, love, generosity, gratitude and highest Truth. These ancient, timeless spiritual principles will always hold true, no matter how chaotic or destitute our world may become, and they will be humanity’s rudder for navigating the stormy seas ahead.

## **Class 2 Course Materials:**

a) *The Crash Course* power point video presentation, by Chris Martenson (research scientist and former Fortune 300 VP), available free on YouTube, or as DVD purchase at [www.chrismartenson.com](http://www.chrismartenson.com), approximately four hours. This series of videos is a clear and straightforward explanation of how our economy, energy systems and environment interact—how we got to where we are today, and some reasonable expectations for the future. The Crash Course is a powerful and predictive view of the challenges and opportunities that await us all and helps us to be aware and prepared.

b) *The Chaos Point: The World at the Crossroads*, book by Erwin Laszlo. We are at a critical juncture in history, a “decision-window” where we face the danger of global collapse—or the opportunity for global renewal. Erwin Laszlo is the founder of systems philosophy and general evolution theory, and in *The Chaos Point* he provides a concise overview of the present world situation, showing where we are and how we got here. According to Laszlo, for the next six to seven years—roughly until the end of 2012—we have the opportunity to head off trends that would lead to a critical tipping point. Beyond this “chaos point,” we either evolve to a safer, more sustainable world, or the social, economic, and ecological systems that frame our life become overstressed and break down. The 2012 chaos point need not be the end of the world, but it will certainly be the end of the kind of world we have created. In today’s decision-window, we have a unique chance to break through to a new world. This pioneering book tells us what this new world can look like and how each of us can help to achieve it. *The Chaos Point* is a healing book. It not only identifies the nature of the malady every person and every society now suffers from, but offers a cure.

## **Class 3: “The History and Future of Money”**

One of the most destructive systems on the planet is the economic system, and it is the roadblock preventing us from moving into a sustainable energy system, which in turn degrades the environment that supports all life on Earth. The current form of the capitalist world economy is one of the root causes for the damage to the Earth’s ecology and the poverty and degradation of most of the world’s population, and—both fortunately and unfortunately—the world economic system certainly appears to be in the process of decline, decay and death. Despite the resulting potential chaos and hardship for humanity, it could also be the very thing that saves us. If the gears that drive the destructive machine of the economy grind to a halt, then perhaps the Earth’s natural systems will have a chance to regenerate. Spiritual truth reminds us that until the old dies, the new cannot be born. Thus, even though we are entering a time of potential chaos, upheaval and the death of the old, the rebirth is also at hand. In this class we will discuss some of the hopeful, inspirational signs of the birth of the new systems that are happening around us now.

## **Class 3 Course Materials:**

a) *The Money Fix*, by Alan Rosenblith (DVD). Available at [www.themoneyfix.org](http://www.themoneyfix.org). *The Money Fix* is a feature-length documentary exploring our society’s relationship with money. While most of us take the monetary system for granted, it has silent and profound

implications for everyone. Have you ever wondered what money is or where it comes from? The truth is that all money enters the economy as bank debt. “So what?” you may ask. This seemingly innocuous detail is actually at the core of many of the social and environmental problems of today.

*The Money Fix* examines economic patterning in both the human and the natural worlds, and through this lens we learn how we can empower ourselves by redesigning the lifeblood of the economy at the community level. The film documents three types of alternative money systems, all of which help solve economic problems for the communities in which they operate. This film will utterly transform the way you perceive money and economics.

b) *The 11th Hour: Turn Mankind's Darkest Hour into its Finest*, by Leonardo diCaprio (DVD). Humankind's 11<sup>th</sup> hour is here: the last moment when we can change course and stop our rush toward ecological collapse. Actor Leonardo DiCaprio produces and narrates this urgent and transformational look at where we've been, where we're going and – most importantly – how we can change. Thinkers from Mikhail Gorbachev to Stephen Hawking to sustainable-design expert William McDonough and dozens more reveal the current, critical state of life on planet Earth. Astonishing images of floods, fires, hurricanes, collapsing ice cliffs and growing mountains of waste juxtaposed with images of a sustainable future urge us to take action. Will we employ exciting new technologies and change our behavior to save our planet? The crisis is now; but we do have the solutions to save this unique blue planet for future generations.

c) *Selected magazine and Internet articles and book excerpts, available online upon registration for the course.*

## **Class 4: “Sacred Activism”**

Andrew Harvey's brilliant and inspiring recent book, *The Hope: A Guide to Sacred Activism*, speaks beautifully to all that we believe in. As he explains, “When... the joy of compassionate service is married to a practical and pragmatic drive to transform all existing economic, social and political institutions, a radical and potentially all-transforming holy force is born. This radical holy force I call Sacred Activism.... My deepest prayer for the vision of Sacred Activism is that it will inspire you to harness the energies of love, both in yourself and with others, and to discover, with wonder and hope, the joy and power of ...that fiery passion of compassion that, when allied with grounded wise action, will help us change everything.”

### **Class 4 Materials:**

a) *The Hope: A Guide to Sacred Activism*, by Andrew Harvey. This book offers not only a guide to discovering your divine purpose but also the blueprint for a better world. It consists of the necessary elements that can inspire greatness in each of us. Based on Harvey's concepts of Sacred Activism, a global initiative designed to save the world from its downward spiral of greed, pain, and self-destruction, the book is an enlightening text that reflects our world today, while in turn, shapes our future.

There are seven laws of Sacred Activism that have the potential to transform our world. Each law, in its own unique way, promotes love above all other impulses. Sacred Activism is about finding gratitude, forgiveness, and compassion; it is about opening yourself up to the kindness within you, letting go of pain, and making a conscious choice to help heal the world.

Learn how to incorporate a spiritual practice into your life, transform anger into positive energy, and take part in a global community. Reclaim a world that for too long has been driven by selfishness and hatred. Discover the infinite joy of giving. Turn away from everything you have been and done and believed, and dive into the consciousness of a divine love that embraces all beings. While the future may appear bleak, *The Hope* provides practical advice to all those who want positive change.

b) *Selfless Giving*, by Leslie Temple-Thurston (audio). Living in a flow of divine grace is one aspect of *karma yoga*, the path of unity through action. To initiate and maintain this flow of abundance in our lives, we must learn to become perfect givers. ## **Class 5: “Facing Our Collective Shadow: Corporations, the Military-Industrial Complex and China”**

Without recognizing and confronting the shadow aspects of the ego, we can never truly live in the flow and fulfill our dreams of abundance, happiness and inner peace. Everyone in a physical body on this planet has a shadow side, unless they have worked at processing and clearing their shadow. It is called “the shadow” because it is hidden from our view, not necessarily because it is dark, demonic or evil, although many people fear the thought of looking at their shadow side because of this misunderstanding. The shadow is also synonymous with what Carl Jung called “the unconscious”. The unconscious shadow in everyone has both a positive and negative aspect. The difficulty with it arises not because it is negative but because it is hidden and projected. When large numbers of people deny or avoid their unconscious shadow, such as fear, the fears are projected and can create phenomena in the outer world. As humanity projects the enemy outside, we cannot help but manifest terrorism, wars, economic crashes, corporate and political greed and corruption, and other destructive forces and crises. In this week’s class we will examine and process our collective shadow in the form of: corporations, the military industrial complex and China.

### **Class 5 Materials:**

a) *Why We Fight*, by Eugene Jarecki (DVD). Grand Jury Prize winner at the 2005 Sundance Film Festival, *Why We Fight* is an unflinching look at the anatomy of American war-making. Granted unparalleled Pentagon access, the film launches a nonpartisan inquiry into the forces—political, economic, and ideological—that drive America to fight. Inspired by President Dwight Eisenhower’s 1961 Farewell Address in which he warned Americans about the dangers of the “military-industrial complex,” filmmaker

Jarecki weaves unforgettable stories of everyday Americans touched by war with commentary by a “who’s who” of military and Washington insiders. Featuring John McCain, Gore Vidal, Richard Perle and others, *Why We Fight* explores a half-century of U.S. foreign policy from World War II to the Iraq War, revealing how, as Eisenhower warned, political and corporate interests have become alarmingly entangled in the business of war. On a deeper level, what emerges is a portrait of a nation in transition—drifting dangerously far from her founding principles toward a more imperial and uncertain future.

b) *Taxi to the Dark Side*, by Alex Gibney (DVD). This 2005 Best Documentary Oscar winner uses interviews, news footage and firsthand reports to examine the Bush administration's policy on torture. The film focuses on the case of an Afghan taxi driver who picked up three passengers and never returned home. Instead, he wound up dead at the Bagram Air Base, killed by injuries inflicted by U.S. soldiers.

c) *The Corporation*, by Mark Achbar and Jennifer Abbott (DVD). This award-winning documentary explores the nature and spectacular rise of the dominant institution of our time. Footage from pop culture, advertising, TV news, and corporate propaganda illuminates the corporation's grip on our lives. Taking its legal status as a “person” to its logical conclusion, the film puts the corporation on the psychiatrist's couch to ask, “What kind of person is it?” Provoking, witty, sweepingly informative. *The Corporation* includes forty interviews with corporate insiders and critics – including Milton Friedman, Noam Chomsky, Naomi Klein, and Michael Moore – plus true confessions, case studies and strategies for change.

d) Excerpts from *The Rise of China and the Demise of the Capitalist World Economy*, by Minqui Li (book excerpts available online upon registration. This book analyzes China's increasing economic power and the impact it is having on our global capitalist system. Economist Minqi Li outlines the possible trajectories for China in the twenty-first century, and what these will mean for the rest of the world. Combining perspectives from Marxism and world-system theories, as well as examining ecological limits to growth, Li argues that China is likely to exacerbate the major contradictions of world capitalism, which could lead to the demise of the existing world-system.

## **Class 6: “Community, Sustainability and Food”**

*“Only when the last tree has been cut down; Only when the last river has been poisoned; Only when the last fish has been caught; Only then will you find that money cannot be eaten.” - Cree Indian Proverb*

As the old, outmoded systems crumble around us, we will need to create new, sustainable ones that are supportive and nurturing to the Earth and humanity. One of the most important is our food system. The films we will watch and discuss this week offer excellent examples of food systems operating in a paradigm of heart-centered consciousness. They are about: community, sharing, giving, nutrition, love, connecting, joy, valuing the Earth and having gratitude for what we are given.

## **Class 6 Materials:**

a) *The Power of Community: How Cuba Survived Peak Oil* (video). Available free online at: <http://video.google.com/videoplay?docid=-1721584909067928384#> . Or on DVD at: [www.powerofcommunity.org](http://www.powerofcommunity.org). When Cuba lost access to Soviet oil in the early 1990s, the country faced an immediate crisis—feeding the population—and an ongoing challenge: how to create a new low-energy society. Cuba transitioned from large, fossil-fuel intensive farming to small, less energy-intensive organic farms and urban gardens, and from a highly industrial society to a more sustainable one. This film tells the story of the Cuban people's hardship, ingenuity and triumph over sudden adversity—through cooperation, conservation and community, told in their own words. As the world approaches Peak Oil, Cuba provides a valuable example of how to successfully address the challenge of reducing our energy use.

b) *Food Fight*, by Chris Taylor (DVD) Available at: <http://www.foodfightthedoc.com/>. A recently released, award-winning documentary, *Food Fight* is a fascinating look at how American agricultural policy and food culture developed in the 20<sup>th</sup> Century, and how the California food movement has created a counter-revolution against big agri-business.

c) *Dirt! The Movie*, by Bill Benenson and Gene Rosow (DVD) Available at: <http://www.dirtthemovie.org/>. This award-winning feature takes you inside the wonders of the soil. It tells the story of Earth's most valuable and underappreciated source of fertility--from its miraculous beginning to its crippling degradation. Narrated by Jaime Lee Curtis, the film brings to life the environmental, economic, social and political impact that the soil has. It shares the stories of experts from all over the world who study and are able to harness the beauty and power of a respectful and mutually beneficial relationship with soil.

d) *Food, Inc.*, Drawing on [Eric Schlosser's](#) *Fast Food Nation* and [Michael Pollan's](#) *The Omnivore's Dilemma*, director [Robert Kenner's](#) Oscar-nominated documentary explores the food industry's detrimental effects on our health and environment. Kenner spotlights the men and women who are working to reform an industry rife with monopolies, questionable interpretations of laws and subsidies, political ties and rising rates of *E. coli* outbreaks.

## **Class 7: “2012 and Beyond”**

*“If you look at the science about what is happening on Earth and aren't pessimistic, you don't understand data. But if you meet the people who are working to restore this earth and the lives of the poor, and you aren't optimistic, you haven't got a pulse.” – Paul Hawken*

Never before in the recorded history of this world have so many people had so little time to do so much. Humanity faces the daunting task of rethinking, redesigning and overhauling practically every system imaginable. Humanity is facing a race against time, as virtually all of our systems begin to crumble and fail. It certainly appears as though in order to accomplish the task, it is going to take vast numbers of people coordinating enormous efforts to make even the smallest difference. Without changing our priorities, shifting our consciousness and getting down to business (the business of surviving) very soon, we stand very little chance of being successful. The process seems daunting and overwhelming, and yet we know miracles are always possible. So many of us feel the

enormous potential for the birth of a new Golden Age in consciousness. Our best chance of succeeding in this extensive overhaul of our earthly home depends entirely on the shift in consciousness of a critical mass of people. The shift hinges on everyone's willingness to participate and make a contribution.

**Class 7 Materials:**

a) *2012: Science or Superstition?* (DVD). December 21, 2012: the end date of the sophisticated Long Count Calendar created by the ancient Maya in Central America. Countless books and websites, magazine articles and newspaper headlines debate its meaning, with enthusiasts in two camps: those forecasting apocalypse—the end of time—and those who see a coming renewal, a rebirth of consciousness. Adding fuel to the debate, some scientists see the increasing number of natural disasters in recent years as evidences of a catastrophic climax of events in 2012. How much of what we're hearing is science and how much is superstition? In this film the leading researchers, writers and scientists in the field tell us exactly what this date means to them, why it's important, and what we should expect.

b) *Blessed Unrest: How the Largest Social Movement in History Is Restoring Grace, Justice, and Beauty to the World*, by Paul Hawken. Across the planet groups ranging from neighborhood associations to well-funded international organizations are confronting issues like the destruction of the environment, the abuses of free-market fundamentalism, social justice, and the loss of indigenous cultures. Though these groups share no unifying ideology or charismatic leader and are mostly unrecognized by politicians and the media, they are bringing about a profound transformation of human society.

In this stirring book, world-renowned environmentalist Paul Hawken tells the story of what is going right in this world. *Blessed Unrest* is the account of how people—from students in Australia to farmers in France, from shoemakers to zoologists and poets—use imagination, conviction, and resilience to redefine our relationship to the environment and to one another, healing the wounds of the Earth with passion and determination. *Blessed Unrest* also features a guide to the project areas being pursued by the environmental and social justice movements—an invaluable resource and inspiration.
